Bulldog Out-of-State Fee Scholarship



Effective Fall 2012

Undergraduate students who are not residents of Louisiana may be eligible for an out-of-state fee scholarship which covers the out-of-state fees. **Incoming Freshman** are automatically considered for Category A with the application for admission, but should contact Admissions if only eligible based on Category B. **Transfer and enrolled students** may obtain the application from the Admissions Office in Hale Hall or on the website at www.latech.edu.

Incoming freshmen – Category A

(Students with fewer than 12 semester hours of college credit)

- Must be admitted.
- ACT 23 or SAT 1050 (CR+M) – any test date before enrollment, and
- 2.5 Overall GPA (on a 4.0 unweighted scale), and
- Have no need for remedial English and Math. *(You do not require remedial courses if your minimum ACT/SAT subscore is English $\geq 18/450$; Math $\geq 19/460$)*

Retention requires full-time enrollment (8 or more credit hrs per quarter), and a cumulative and quarter GPA of 2.00.

Transfer and Enrolled Students* – Category B

(Students with at least 12 semester hours of college credit, including dual enrollment hours)

- Must be admitted with completed transcript(s) on file.
- 12 semester hours of college credit, and
- Cumulative 2.75 GPA, and
- Have no need for remedial English and Math. *(You do not require remedial courses if your minimum ACT/SAT subscore is English $\geq 18/450$; Math $\geq 19/460$ or have taken courses equivalent to college level English and College Algebra)*
- Students should complete the application at least two weeks prior to the quarter.

Retention requires full-time enrollment (8 or more credit hrs per quarter), and a cumulative and quarter GPA of 2.00.

*Alternate category for incoming freshman

Special Categories:

Category C:

Students whose parent(s) graduated from Louisiana Tech University are treated as in-state for tuition purposes. The parent information section of the application for admission should be completed.

Category D:

Non-resident students who enroll in 6 or fewer credit hours per quarter are treated as in-state for tuition purposes.
